CHAPTER SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETES SECURITY UPGRADES

Renovations and Increased Security at Buen Retiro

The new 22-room back addition is entering its fourth year and it has continually proven beneficial for the Fraternity. With the new addition and a final construction cost of just under \$6 million, we raised \$5.7 million through our campaign, thanks to you. In regards to our beloved Buen Retiro, we replaced the wood floors last fall and painted and replaced the ceiling on the main floor over spring break. Last year, we completed the fencing and drive gates to the entire property, safely securing our assets from vandalism. In addition, security lighting and cameras were added as a deterrent.

At this time, the Purple Owl House Corporation has voted to hold off on any new capital projects, including the Chapter room expansion until our loan on the back addition is paid off. We recently paid down the loan by \$166,840, which leaves a remaining balance of \$573,658 (as of April 10, 2018) with Plains Capital. With the remaining pledges due totaling just over \$200,000 and rental income from the new addition, our goal is to retire the debt within three years. The col-

lection of every pledge will greatly expedite this goal and reduce ongoing interest expense. Please check to see if you have a remaining pledge due as every dollar reduces our principle loan amount, thereby expediting the loan payoff. Texas Fiji Awards \$525,000 for Scholarships



A. Stuart Delgado Jr. '30 was born January 12, 1913, in Memphis, Tennessee. He graduated from Highland Park High School and the University of Texas, where he was an active member of the swim team and the Phi Gamma Delta Fraternity. He served in the U.S. Navy during WWII teaching at the Naval Academy in Chicago and serving as port director in Singapore. He retired with the rank of Lt. commander and remained active in the naval reserve. He retired in 1977 from Atlantic Richfield Corp. He was preceded in death by his wife of 62 years, Margaret Sears Delgado.

Mr. Delgado loved his University and his Texas Fiji brothers and left in his will a significant portion of his estate to UT to benefit members of the Tau Deuteron Chapter of the Phi Gamma Delta Fraternity at the University of Texas.

This is the fourth year of awards since the establishment of the scholarship in 2016. The endowment is currently managed by The Texas Exes Association. The Fiji Scholarship Committee reviews the list of eligible candidates provided by Texas Exes through their formal application process. Awards are formally announced at the annual Pig Dinner ceremonies each spring. To date, more than \$525,000 has been awarded to 71 eligible Texas Fijis. The Fiji Scholarship Committee is reviewing formal applications for academic year 2018-19, with awards expected to exceed \$175,000.

We are grateful to Brother Delgado for his generous gift and are honored to fulfill his final request to award scholarship funds to deserving Texas Fijis.

Texas Fiji Excels in Philanthropic Contributions and Academics

This spring, Texas Fiji has gone above and beyond to attain our goals. From attaining a GPA above the university all-men and IFC averages to the sophomores successfully completing their traditional canoe trip down the Rio Grande, the men of Phi Gamma Delta set the example for all fraternities at The University of Texas.

Brothers Maintain Delgado Legacy

After achieving a 3.24 GPA and 3.27 new member GPA, Texas Fiji is eager to continue this dedication to academics. We have implemented study hall requirements for all members below a 2.25 GPA. Penalties include not being allowed to run for an office, not being able to live in the chapter house, and social penalties. Our goal is to earn the best GPA in the Greek community and continue to beat the average.

Texas Fiji Scholarships honor excellent behavior to those who exemplify what it means to be a Fiji. There are five existing awards with three new awards this year and one in progress. These scholarships total \$175,000 annually.

Texas Fiji Raises Over \$50,000

Our brothers have continued to be pillars in the community through their service. We logged more than 600 volunteer hours last semester and raised more than \$50,000. The fall pledge class raised more than \$5,000 in their initial drive for Alzheimer's Texas, which will become an annual event for pledge classes and include partnerships with the Greek community. The Chapter also raised \$32,670 for B+ for childhood cancer research and raised more than \$5,800 at the Low Hoops tournament for a UT basketball player, Andrew Jones, who is battling leukemia.
